Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize/overweight permit are: length – 120', width – 13'6", height – 15'6", weight - 156,000 lbs. Enter actual dimensions if self-propelled oversize/overweight vehicle.

This permit is valid only for roads within the City of Altoona. It is not valid for travel on county roads, state highways, interstate highways, or city streets. Separate permits must be obtained from the proper governing authority for travel on these roadways.

Permits can be issued only for transporting single articles that exceed statutory size limits unless the inclusion of additional articles does not cause the size or weight to further exceed the statutory limits.

It is the responsibility of the carrier to route themselves around low clearances, construction projects, and embargoed roads. Route approval is required for ALL bridge crossings. If carrier demonstrates inability to self-route, the permit is revoked.
