READ CAREFULLY

PERMIT MUST BE POSTED AT WATER SERVICE ENTRANCE.

Except as provided by law, where plumbing work has been started prior to obtaining a permit, the regular fee therefore shall be doubled. Violations of Municipal Code are punishable by \$750 fine per Chapter 4 of the Municipal Code.

The Permittee is assumed to be knowledgeable of the Plumbing Code. Any questions should be resolved prior to installation.

It is the responsibility of the Permittee to call for all inspections. Phone 967-5138. 24-hour notice is required. Permittee must be present for inspections.

Permits are non-transferrable. All work shall be performed by Permittee or its employee.

No plumbing work shall be concealed or covered until approved by the inspector. Work that is not tagged with an approval shall be considered unapproved. **ALL WORK MUST BE INSPECTED.**

The issuance or granting of a permit or approval of plans and specifications shall not be construed to be a permit for, or an approval of, any violation of any of the provisions of this code. No permit presuming to give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of this code shall be valid, except insofar as the work or use which it authorizes is lawful.

The issuance of a permit based upon plans and specifications shall not prevent the Building Inspector from requiring the correction of errors in said plans and specifications or from preventing construction being carried on thereunder when in violation of any Municipal Code or ordinance.

Any permit may be revoked by the Building Inspector for violation of any provision of Municipal Code or ordinance or other applicable law.

This plumbing permit shall expire if work is not commenced within 180 days or if work is abandoned for 180 days. Before the work can be recommenced, a new permit shall be obtained and the fee therefore shall be one-half of the amount required for a new permit for the work, provided that the suspension or abandonment has not exceeded one year.

Refunds. If, within 60 days of the date of issuance, the holder of a plumbing permit decides not to commence the work described in said permit, he or she may, upon notification to the Building Department, be refunded 80 percent of the total permit fee, but in no case shall the remaining 20 percent be less than \$10.00. The refund of any fee of \$10.00 or less shall not be made.

Underground irrigation systems are allowed in City right-of-way with the understanding that any repair of the irrigation system caused by maintenance of utilities will be at the homeowner's expense.
