The property is located on the west side of 14th Avenue SW (NE 80th Street) on the southwest side of the eastern lake and is 7.21 acres in size. The plat consists of 19 single family lots. The property is zoned R-1 (Single-family Residential). The lots are required to be 8,750sf in size. The smallest lot in this plat is 9,803sf and is 75' wide.

The addition is 9,250sf and will bring the total footprint of the building to 87,527sf.
